

 - a tropical cyclone warning signal is hoisted
 - there is a/an amber, red or black rainstorm warning
 - a thunderstorm forecast/warning is issued
9. All outdoor activities will be cancelled without prior notice when the Forecast of Health Risk of the Air Quality Health Index is Serious (AQHI Scale 10+) for General Stations.
10. Please treasure educational resources. If you decide to cancel the booking, please notify the Centre at your earliest convenience.
11. Participants are advised to bring drinking water, mosquito repellent and sun block. Attention must be paid to the following measures and code:
 - Wear suitable outdoor clothing.
 - Drink plenty of water.
 - Treasure our nature. Do not disturb wildlife nor collect plants.
